Percent of alumni saying faculty were **interested in students personally and academically:**

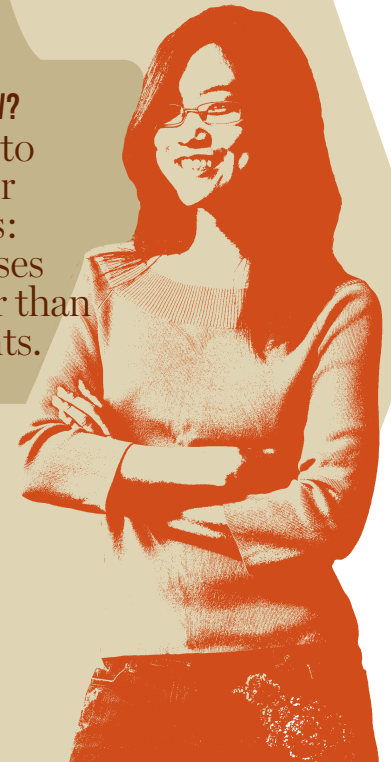

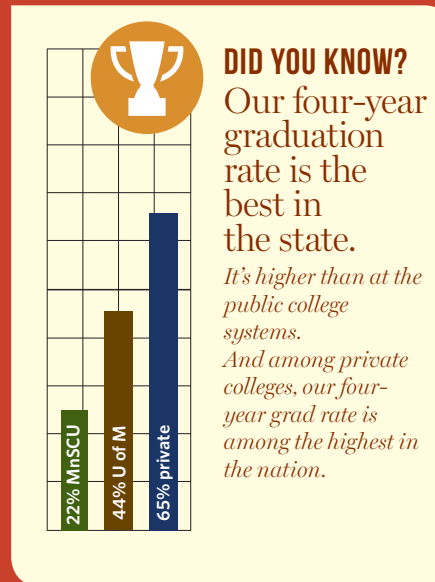
